MARCH 16 – MAY 15	Newsletter blackout dates (*HR 14.30)
MAY 15	Primary Election
APRIL 13	Governor’s deadline to sign bills, 2018 Regular Session (**Article V, Section 15b)
MAY 21 – 24	Legislative Committee and Task Force Days
JUNE 2	91 st Day Following Adjournment Sine Die. 91 st day is an <u>early</u> effective date for bills (**Article IV, Section 28).
SEPTEMBER 7 – NOVEMBER 6	Newsletter blackout dates (*HR 14.30)
NOVEMBER 6	General Election
SEPTEMBER 24 – 27	Legislative Committee and Task Force Days
SEPTEMBER 28	Members and committees shall submit requests for drafts of measures to be pre-session-filed to LC no later than 5:00 p.m. (SCR 206, 2018 Regular Session)
DECEMBER 5	Pre-session-filed draft requests submitted to LC by September 28 will be returned to members or committees by 5:00 p.m. (SCR 206, 2018 Regular Session)
DECEMBER 11 – 14	Legislative Committee and Task Force Days
DECEMBER 14 (December 15 is a Saturday)	Deadline for the Executive & Judiciary to file measures for the 2019 Regular Session is December 15 (**ORS 171.130).
DECEMBER 21	Deadline to drop bills with the Chief Clerk for pre-session filed drafts (by 5:00 p.m.). These measures will be introduced and read first time during Organizational Days (SCR 206, 2018 Regular Session).

JANUARY 1	<u>Normal</u> effective date for bills, 2018 Regular Session (**ORS 171.022)
JANUARY 14 – 16	Organizational Session Days. January 14 – Members will be sworn in; all pre-session-filed measures introduced (first read); and the Senate and House will meet in joint session for the purpose of swearing-in the Governor (**Article IV, Section 4).
JANUARY 22	START OF REGULAR SESSION (If Governor signs SB 1542, 2018 Regular Session)
JUNE 30	Constitutional Sine Die (160 calendar days following January 22) (If Governor signs SB 1542, 2018 Regular Session)
