JANUARY 1	Normal effective date for bills, 2020 Regular Session ⁶
JANUARY 11 – ?	Organizational Session Day(s). January 11 – Members will be sworn in; all pre-session filed measures introduced (first read); and the Senate and House will meet in joint session for the purpose of receiving the Governor's State of the State Address ⁷
JANUARY 19	START OF REGULAR SESSION ⁸
JUNE 27	Constitutional Sine Die ⁹ (160 calendar days)
