## Government – to – Government Annual Report 2010

In 2010, as in prior years, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission worked with its tribal partners to promote the public interest through the responsible sales and service of alcoholic beverages. Agency staff continued to provide information and technical support to the tribes regarding liquor regulatory issues at licensed tribal businesses. The focus of that work ensured that changes to licensed businesses continue to promote the public interest and safety. As part of that commitment, agency staff attended Tribal Information Day on May 14, 2010.

### **Eugene Regional Office**

Since the tribal key contacts are in the Eugene Regional Office, the Eugene Regional Office supports other regions in providing services to tribes statewide in addition to the work that other regional offices provide to individual tribes.

The Eugene Regional Office and Roseburg office worked with the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians to approve a remodel of a restaurant at Seven Feathers Hotel & Casino Resort

### **The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde**

The Eugene and Salem Regional Offices worked with the Confederated Tribes of Grande Ronde to extend its liquor license to include alcoholic beverage service in the Summit High Stake and The Peak areas of Spirit Mountain Casino.

### **Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation**

The Eugene Regional Office and the Pendleton satellite office of the Bend Region has consulted with the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation concerning its expansion at the Wildhorse Resort and Casino.

### **Liquor Enforcement Activities**

The agency continues to offer and provide training concerning the identification of visibly intoxicated people. This includes training servers and other staff how to refuse alcoholic beverage sales to visibly intoxicated people, and to effectively manage patrons who begin to show signs of visible intoxication. Agency staff also continues to provide similar training on the identification of minors and the prevention of sale and service of alcoholic beverages to minors.
