The offices of the Oregon Department of Education (ODE), the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development (OCCWD), the Oregon University System (OUS), Teachers Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC), and the Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC), with the nine Oregon tribes have been involved in various projects and activities during calendar year 2010. The TSPC representative (Keith Menk, Deputy Director) has attended many of the scheduled meetings.

2010 Involvement:

- Continued participation with the Government to Government, Education cluster meetings and related projects and activities;
- Updated the cluster participants on changes to *Protecting Student and Civil Rights in the Educational Environment Examination* for licensed educators;
- Provided ongoing information to the cluster on the proposed changes to licensure program and administrative rules for pre-K-12 licensed educators; and
- Reported that Oregon currently has ten licensed educators in Native American languages, down from the high of twelve last year.
