

**Government to Government Indian Education Cluster
2007 Annual Report
Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission**

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE), the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development (OCCWD), the Oregon University System (OUS), Teachers Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC), and the Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC), in conjunction with the nine Oregon tribes, have been involved in various projects and activities during calendar year 2007. The TSPC representative has attended many of the scheduled meetings. In addition to the projects of the Government to Government Education Cluster projects and activities, TSPC has been involved in several other activities:

- TSPC held the summer 2007 meeting in Pendleton which included a presentation by Licensed Native Language Teachers from the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation;
- Tour of Tamastlikt Cultural Institute by the Commission and various stakeholders which was followed by dinner;
- Met with representatives of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla to discuss the civil rights workshop licensure requirement for all licensed Oregon educators;
- Presenter on Oregon licensure and educator preparation programs at the Pshwayii Native American Language Teachers Conference at Kah-Nee-Ta on March 29 and 30.

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
