



Oregon Community College Report for SB 595 (2009) Revised

SB 595 (2009) requires Oregon's community colleges to report to the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly how the financial needs for dependents of veterans who died on active duty, died as a result of a military service connected disability, or were 100% disabled as the result of a military connected are accommodated. Qualified students include a child, a spouse, or an un-remarried surviving spouse of a member of the United States Armed Forces.

For the last three years, the colleges report the following for dependents of veterans:

- a. 44 qualified students received a waiver, for a total of \$52,261.
- b. 2 scholarships were offered specifically to qualified students, 2 qualified students received those scholarships, for a total of \$16,629.
- c. Qualified students receive Federal Financial Aid, in addition to the tuition waivers.
