## **Executive Summary**

The OBD is fully supportive of the legislation regarding temporary authorizations to spouses or domestic partners of members of the Armed Forces of the United States who are stationed in Oregon. The OBD is proactive and helpful with every applicant for licensure through our Board. The OBD issued no temporary licenses of any kind in 2019. The OBD received no applications meeting SB 688 criteria. The OBD works closely with other health boards in the state and reviews their efforts in this area. Since we received no applications, we have not spent any significant time on this area of licensure. The OBD developed and approved temporary rules which have an effective date of January 1, 2020 based on the provisions in SB 688 and HB 3030. Our temporary rules can be reviewed on our website, or I can send them to anyone who requests them. The OBD stands ready to assist the Legislature, applicants or any interested party on this matter.
