RE: HB 4106 – Report on Rulemaking

House Bill 4106 (2016) asks state agencies to report annually on their rulemaking actions, both permanent and temporary.

In 2019 the OBMI completed six permanent rulemaking actions that amended three and adopted two rules. OBMI completed no temporary rulemaking actions in 2019. Table 1 below gives additional detail.
