




Immunizations in Oregon

In 2016
94.2%
of students

in kindergarten through 12th grade were complete for all of the school-required vaccines.

In the 2015/2016 flu season, 43% of Oregonians received a flu vaccination, compared to 41% the previous season. A flu vaccine is recommended annually for all people 6 months and older.

Human Papillomavirus (HPV)



Each year, 27,000 men and women in the United States are diagnosed with an HPV-related cancer. That's one every 20 minutes! About 21,000 cases could be prevented by HPV vaccination.

HPV vaccination is a two or three dose vaccination series. If administered on time, the series can be completed within six months.

ALERT IIS is a statewide immunization registry developed to achieve complete and timely immunizations of all Oregonians throughout their lives.
