Statement of Need

OYA is amending the date and content of the Behavioral Rehabilitation Services (BRS) Rate Table referenced in OAR 416-335-0090 to incorporate Qualified Residential Treatment Programs as part of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA).

Justification

OYA finds that failure to act promptly will result in serious prejudice to the public interest, OYA, and Behavioral Rehabilitation Services (BRS) providers. OYA needs its BRS providers to provide behavioral residential services to youth offenders in the community. In order to pay its BRS providers and Qualified Residential Treatment Programs as part of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) at a current rate, OYA must update OAR 416-335-0090.
