RE: HB 2835 (2019) Waterway Closure reporting

As required by HB 2835 (2019) Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is reporting on closures and restrictions of public access to waterways during the 2020 calendar year.

The agency had no planned closures lasting longer than 30 days; however, emergency closures due to wildfire, COVID and flooding did impact public access to waterways throughout the state. OPRD continues repairs and remediation of fire damage with the goal of reopening many sites in 2021. Below is a table indicating closures on state park properties that impacted waterway access in 2020.
