SUMMARY

Modifies amounts of lottery funds allocated from Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to state agencies.

Modifies amounts allocated from Veterans' Services Fund.

Modifies amounts allocated from Criminal Fine Account.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; amending sections 3, 4, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13 and 16, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 3, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

(1) *Operations*..... \$ 8,773,826]

Operations..... \$ **8,218,278**

(2) Business, innovation

and trade..... \$ 57,965,174]

and trade..... \$ **50,014,240**

(3) *Infrastructure* \$ 5,351,472]

Infrastructure..... \$ **3,751,472**

(4) Infrastructure - Tide

Gates and Culverts Program \$ 6,000,000]

Gates and Culverts Program \$ **3,000,000**

5 **SECTION 2.** Section 4, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
6 read:

7 **Sec. 4.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from
8 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Department
9 of Education, for the State School Fund, the amount of [~~\$530,146,857~~]
10 **\$330,467,530.**

11 **SECTION 3.** Section 7, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
12 read:

13 **Sec. 7.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall es-
14 tablish a process for allocating available moneys in the Administrative Ser-
15 vices Economic Development Fund on a quarterly basis to fulfill the biennial
16 allocations made by sections 1 to 12a, **chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019** [*of*
17 *this 2019 Act*]. The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

18 (2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund
19 to the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient
20 to pay for the quarterly allocations made by sections 1 to 12a, **chapter 670,**
21 **Oregon Laws 2019,** [*of this 2019 Act*] or any other 2019 Act, prior to making
22 any other allocations pursuant to sections 1 to 12a, **chapter 670, Oregon**
23 **Laws 2019** [*of this 2019 Act*], the department shall satisfy lottery bond debt
24 service obligations in the amount of [~~\$263,661,510~~] **\$259,868,206** for outstand-
25 ing lottery bonds.

26 (3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection
27 (2) of this section are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the
28 State Lottery Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development
29 Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by sections
30 1 to 12a, **chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019** [*of this 2019 Act*], the department
31 shall reduce the quarterly allocations not described in subsection (2) of this

1 section proportionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue
2 shortfall.

3 **SECTION 4.** Section 8, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
4 read:

5 **Sec. 8.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from
6 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon
7 Department of Administrative Services, the amount of [~~\$263,661,510~~]
8 **\$259,868,206** for the purpose of paying, when due, the principal, interest and
9 premium, if any, on outstanding lottery bonds, as described in section 7,
10 **chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019** [*of this 2019 Act*].

11 **SECTION 5.** Section 10, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
12 read:

13 **Sec. 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549
14 (2) for a percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning
15 July 1, 2019, the amount allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
16 nomic Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund is
17 [~~\$14,593,071~~] **\$14,578,599**.

18 **SECTION 6.** Section 12, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
19 read:

20 **Sec. 12.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the allocation described in sec-
21 tion 2 (3), chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 99 (2016)), for a
22 percentage-based transfer of moneys with an annual cap, for the biennium
23 beginning July 1, 2019, the amount allocated from the Administrative Ser-
24 vices Economic Development Fund to the Outdoor School Education Fund
25 is [~~\$45,305,847~~] **\$43,040,555**.

26 **SECTION 7.** Section 13, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to
27 read:

28 **Sec. 13.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from
29 the Veterans' Services Fund, to the Veterans' Department of Veterans' Af-
30 fairs Dedicated Lottery Fund, the following amounts for the following pur-
31 poses:

- 2 **Veterans' Services Program**..... \$ 10,525,837
- 3 (2) County Veterans' Service

13 and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Criminal Fine
14 Account, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 15 (1) Criminal justice training
- 16 [*and standards operations*..... \$ 31,999,031]
- 17 **and standards operations**..... \$ 29,817,371
- 18 (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund \$ 279,495

19 **SECTION 9.** This 2020 second special session Act being necessary for
20 the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an
21 emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 second special session Act
22 takes effect on its passage.
