DRAZAN SWORN IN AS STATE REPRESENTATIVE

SALEM, Ore. – Today, **Christine Drazan (R - Canby)** was sworn in to represent House District 51 in the State Legislature for the 83rd Legislative Assembly. Drazan previously served in the legislature between 2019 and 2022. “It is an honor to represent our community in the State Legislature once again,” said **Rep. Drazan**. “Whether it’s affordability, education, homelessness, or addiction, we need to work together as a Legislature to get real results that improve the lives of Oregon families,” Drazan added.

Rep. Drazan will be proposing legislation to:

- Lower taxes for Oregon families
- Make schools more responsive to students and their families
- Ban costly tolling
- Respond to infrastructure needs across the district

Last November, House Republicans elected Rep. Drazan House Republican Leader. “As House Republican Leader, I look forward to being a voice for the many Oregonians who don’t feel heard and are experiencing a government that isn’t working on their behalf,” said Drazan. “House Republicans are committed to fighting for Oregonians that have been harmed by failed policies and false promises,” concluded Drazan.

Rep. Drazan will serve as Vice Chair of the Rules committee, and as a member on the Ways and Means, Legislative Administration, Legislative Counsel, and Legislative Policy and Research Committees, along the Ways and Means Capital Construction Subcommittee.
