Ferrioli to serve on additional committees

Salem – Senator Ted Ferrioli (R-John Day) has been appointed by the Senate President to serve on the Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Counsel Committee and the Capitol Foundation. These committees deal with the administration, preservation and future of the state capitol building, legislative process and capitol mall.

“I consider this an opportunity to safeguard the traditions and legacy of Oregon’s capitol, and help set a roadmap for the future of this institution,” said Ferrioli. “It is an honor to serve Oregon on these committees.”

Ferrioli, who is the Senate Republican Leader, is also Vice-Chair of the Senate Rules Committee and serves on the Commission on Indian Services, Oregon Broadband Advisory Council, the Asset Forfeiture Oversight Advisory Committee, and the Western States Legislative Forestry Task Force.

Ferrioli is the longest-serving member of the Oregon State Senate. He was first elected in 1996 and has been a fierce advocate for rural Oregon.
