Representative Lynn Findley Appointed as Vice Chair of the House Committee on Revenue and Co-Vice Chair on the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures

Salem, OR – [House Speaker Tina Kotek](#) (D-Portland) released committee assignments for the upcoming 2019 Legislative Session on Wednesday evening. [Representative Lynn Findley](#) (R-Vale) has been appointed to be the Vice Chair on the House Committee on Revenue, Co-Vice Chair on the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures, and a member of the House Committee on Energy and Environment, House Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness, and on the Joint Committee on Transportation.

Rep. Findley stated, “I am looking forward to getting to work for the people of House District 60. These committee assignments, especially as Vice Chair on the Revenue Committee, will give Eastern Oregonians a unique voice in shaping tax policies.” Findley went on to say, “I know that a lot of people in Eastern Oregon feel like their voices aren’t heard in Salem and don’t matter, but I’m here to tell you that they do matter. I will do everything in my power during this next Session to work across the aisle and to promote Eastern Oregon values with every vote that I take.”

Rep. Findley was originally appointed to fill the vacancy that Sen. Cliff Bentz left in January 2018. He then ran unopposed, garnering the Republican, Democrat, and Independent nominations. Rep. Findley was elected to the Oregon House of Representatives on November 6, 2018.
