PROCLAMATION

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS: Wildfires increasingly pose a threat to homes and communities throughout the West as

more people move into the wildland areas of our state. Most of these fires are human

caused; and

WHEREAS: This continuing growth of communities into the wildland-urban interface has elevated the

need for wildfire prevention and preparedness at both the community and individual

homeowner levels; and

WHEREAS: A long-term climate trend and the build-up of forest fuels have further increased the

wildfire risk. These factors, coupled with the expansion of the wildland-urban interface,

are challenging efforts to protect citizens, property and our natural resources; and

WHEREAS: Wildfires are an essential ecosystem process which cannot be eliminated from our

landscapes. Therefore, coordinated education concerning how, where, and why wildfires burn, as well as collaborative efforts to increase durability of homes and property are

paramount in co-existing in a fire environment; and

WHEREAS: The local, state and federal wildfire agencies of Oregon in partnership with fire

prevention organizations in the state, are working together to increase awareness of

wildfires.

NOW,

THEREFORE: I, Kate Brown, Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby proclaim May 2020 to be

WILDFIRE AWARENESS MONTH

in Oregon and encourage all Oregonians to join in this observance.
