Sen. Monnes Anderson and Rep. Gorsek Announce Town Hall on Education

East County Legislators Talk K-12 Education

TROUTDALE – Senator Laurie Monnes Anderson (D-Gresham) and Representative Chris Gorsek (D-Troutdale) today announced they will hold a joint Town Hall in March to discuss the education issues with their constituents.

“I’m focused on East County schools as a top priority this session,” Monnes Anderson said. “I’ve heard from my constituents that we need to keep teachers in the classroom and reduce class sizes. I look forward to hearing more about how we can provide an excellent education for East County students.”

“I’ve been speaking with people throughout East Multnomah County, and education funding is at the top of their minds,” said Gorsek. “In these tough economic times, we need to make sure we have our priorities straight. I’m working with my colleagues in the House to make sure we are doing everything we can to reinvest in our students.”

The town hall will focus on K-12 education, including the proposed education budget that was released today. Sen. Monnes Anderson and Rep. Gorsek will be joined by several guests from within Oregon’s education system.
