**Representative Jodi Hack Appointed To Department Of Energy Oversight  
Committee**

*Salem Area Representative To Help Reform Troubled Agency*

**Salem, OR** – Representative Jodi Hack (R-Salem) has been appointed by House leadership to serve as a member of the Joint Committee on Department of Energy Oversight. The newly formed committee will be tasked with reforming the long-troubled agency.

“I’m honored to have been selected to serve on this committee and to have the opportunity to play a role in reforming the Department of Energy,” said Rep. Hack. “Clearly, there has been a pattern of serious problems related to this agency. We as legislators have an obligation to thoroughly investigate past failures and develop a strategy to strengthen the level of accountability and oversight of this agency.”

The Joint Committee on Department of Energy Oversight is expected to hold its first meetings during the 2016 legislative session. The committee will study past problems involving the Energy Department and prepare recommendations and potential legislation to be considered by the Legislature in 2017.
