Rep. Jodi Hack on Education Funding: What Are Our Quality Goals?

House Republicans today continued to share with their colleagues some concerns from school districts over the proposed \$7.235 billion K-12 budget for the 2015-2017 biennium.

During today's House Floor session, House Republican Deputy Whip Jodi Hack (R-Salem) read a letter from Salem-Keizer Public Schools Superintendent Christy Perry on behalf of the 40,000 Oregon students that attend Salem-Keizer public schools. According to Superintendent Perry, the current education budget proposal would result in a total revenue loss of \$3.5 million to Salem-Keizer Public Schools, forcing the

school district to draw from reserves to fund full-day kindergarten while also preventing crucial investments in infrastructure, technology and instructional materials.

Just as [Rep. Sprenger yesterday](#) called on her fellow House members to do better for Oregon students, Rep. Hack today challenged her colleagues to ask themselves what they believe constitutes a quality education in Oregon.
