**Northeastern Oregon Delegation Secures Funding for Critical
Local Projects**

SALEM, Ore. – Today the legislature passed funding for critical projects around the region. The legislative delegation from North East Oregon worked together to secure money for some of the most important projects in the region with a focus on infrastructure, public safety, mental health, and economic development.

“I am very pleased with the results of our Northeastern Oregon delegation’s efforts” Senator Bill Hansell stated. “A lot of important projects got funded, I am really proud of how we worked as a team to get it done.”
