Senator Bill Hansell To Hold Town Hall Meeting in Milton-Freewater

What to Consider When Deciding How to Budget the Citizens' Tax Dollars

Salem, Or – State Senator Bill Hansell (R-Athena) of District 29 will be holding a town hall at 7:00pm Wednesday, January 28th at the Milton-Freewater American Legion Hall, 424 NE 8th, Milton-Freewater. The town hall is hosted by the Milton-Freewater Tea Party. All citizens and city officials of District 29 are invited.

Hansell has been named to three committees for the 78th Legislative Assembly: the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, Ways and Means Sub-Committee on Economic Development and Transportation, and Ways and Means Sub-Committee on Natural Resources. Every bill that affects state revenue will go through the appropriate Ways and Means Sub-Committee prior to a vote by the full Ways and Means Committee.

“Transportation issues are very important to District 29,” Hansell said. “I would like to get feedback on possible transportation projects, and I would like to hear what issues or concerns our citizens might have as well.”

In addition to transportation issues, Hansell would like to have a discussion with the people of Senate District 29 regarding issues they feel will be important in this legislative session.

Senator Hansell has been a campus minister, a rancher and a Umatilla County Commissioner. He is a graduate of Athena public schools, the University of Oregon, and the Harvard University JFK School of Government.
