On Easter Weekend the Mobile Dental Unit of Caring Hands Worldwide swung into action to serve Veterans at the Fall Creek Event Center.



Veterans attending were served a substantial breakfast before rotating to the dental stations. Services offered included examinations, x-rays, cleanings, fillings and extractions, as well as Life Style Counseling. The veterans, who represented branches of service including the Marines, Navy, Airforce and Army ranged in age from 27 to 67, came from Oakridge, Springfield, Eugene, Lane Community College, and the University of Oregon.
