Representative Cedric Hayden Begins Legislative Career

Salem, OR – Today, Representative Cedric Hayden (R-Fall Creek) was sworn in for his first term as a member of the Oregon House of Representatives. Rep. Hayden joined his colleagues in the House Chamber for the swearing-in ceremony administered by Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court, Thomas A. Balmer.

“I’m honored to have the opportunity to serve the people of House District 7 in Salem,” said Rep. Hayden. “I’m optimistic about the prospects of working with my legislative colleagues on both sides of the aisle to bring quality health care to rural Oregon, ensure our state’s most vulnerable citizens have access to the care they need, and develop meaningful education reforms.”
