## 100 Days In: Oregon Pushes Back Against Harmful Federal Policies

**SALEM, Ore. –** It's been 100 days of President Trump's second term, and his administration's policies are already hurting families, businesses, and communities across the state.

"The Trump administration is creating chaos in Oregon and across the country. He is damaging our economy and increasing the cost of living," said **House Majority Leader Ben Bowman** (**D-Tigard, Metzger, & S. Beaverton**). "Trump's reckless tariffs alone will cost Oregon families thousands of extra dollars a year. His decisions are putting pressure on wallets and disrupting the industries essential to Oregon's economy."

Earlier this month, <u>The Oregonian reported</u> a federal freeze on \$225 million in grants has endangered vital clean water initiatives and emergency preparedness programs, critical to the health and safety of Oregonians.

## Bills Already Passed By House Democrats: Fighting For Affordability

- HB 3546 Requires data centers pay their fair share and can't pass costs along to consumers
- <u>HB 2010</u> Funds the Oregon Health Plan to ensure Oregonians receive health care and saves the state and taxpayers money on emergency health care
- HB 3054 Puts a 6% cap on rent increases for folks living in manufactured homes
- HB 3533 Says companies can't surprise buyers with hidden fees tacked on at check out
- HB 3167 Stops people or software from buying up tickets for events and selling them at a higher price
- HB 3178 Makes sure a car dealer sticks to the agreed upon financing when folks leave the lot

Across the state, thousands have taken to the streets in peaceful protest, demonstrating their opposition to these reckless policies. Governor Tina Kotek, Attorney General Dan Rayfield, and Oregon House Democrats are holding the line against federal overreach — defending our values of fairness, opportunity, and inclusion.
