Majority Leader Bowman Releases Statement on Stable September Revenue Forecast

SALEM, Ore. – Today, **House Majority Leader Ben Bowman (D-Tigard, Metzger, & S. Beaverton)** issued the following statement on the September Revenue Forecast released this morning by the Oregon Office of Economic Analysis:

“Our state’s economy remains stable and poised for continued growth. This is great news. But the cost of housing, healthcare, and utilities is still too high for working families,” said **Rep. Bowman**. “In the 2025 legislative session, we will work to build on the momentum of our economic growth to make sure working families are sharing in the benefits of our stable economy.”
