## **Statement From Majority Leader Val Hoyle on the May Revenue Forecast**

“In March, we passed the K-12 budget early, so that school districts across the state can start planning early for the next two years. In order to give schools even more money, House Democrats voted to automatically send additional dollars to classrooms based on the May revenue forecast.

“Because of that vote, we learned today that more than \$105 million will automatically be available for K-12 classrooms. These dollars will help districts make investments that will improve education for kids across the state.

“At the same time, today’s good news means that we’ll be able to fund critical budget needs including public safety, services for struggling families, and higher education—and set aside some money in savings to help us through future tough times.”
