Rep. Akasha Lawrence Spence Sworn In

Lawrence Spence represents House District 36

SALEM, Ore. – Rep. Akasha Lawrence Spence (D-Portland) was sworn in today as the representative for Oregon House District 36 which covers portions of Northwest and Southwest Portland. Oregon Supreme Court Justice Adrienne Nelson administered the oath of office on the floor of the Oregon House of Representatives.

"...there is no greater purpose in life than to live in service to others, so today, I want to thank you all for trusting me with the privilege of serving you, our community, our district, our county, and our state," Rep. Lawrence Spence said.

Rep. Lawrence Spence is a small business owner of a conscientious urban development firm and was most recently a member of the Portland Planning and Sustainability Commission. She also founded Melanated, a women of color organization focused on civic engagement, financial empowerment, and community stewardship.
