House Republican Leader Mike McLane thanks former Rep. John Huffman for his service to the State of Oregon

Salem, Ore. - House Republican Leader Mike McLane (R-Powell Butte) issued the following statement commending former Representative John Huffman for his decade-plus of service as a state lawmaker:

Representative Huffman submitted his formal resignation letter to Secretary of State Dennis Richardson on Saturday, October 28, 2017. Republican precinct committee persons will now be tasked with nominating 3-5 candidates to fill the vacancy in House District 59. County commissioners from Wasco, Wheeler, Jefferson and Deschutes Counties will then vote to appoint the next representative for the district from the group of nominated candidates. This process must take place within 30 days of the resignation date.
