### **Statement From House Republican Leader Mike McLane On Governor Brown's 2016 Policy Agenda**

**Salem, OR** – House Republican Leader Mike McLane (R-Powell Butte) issued the following statement regarding Governor Brown's 2016 Policy Agenda:

"I'm disappointed in the Governor's proposed 2016 agenda. A 'healthy, vibrant' Oregon will only be achieved when our state leaders show the political courage necessary to tackle our most pressing issues. We're facing a massive PERS shortfall, our roads and infrastructure are in need of repair now, our rural communities are in crisis, and our education system ranks as one of the worst in the nation.
