Statement from House Republican Leader Christine Drazan

SALEM, Ore. – House Republican Leader Christine Drazan (R-Canby) has released the following statement:

"Oregonians should be disappointed that Democrats have apparently thrown in the towel and refuse to participate in good faith conversations moving forward. We are not asking for secret negotiations or last-minute deals. We have repeatedly and publicly asked the majority party to allow the people of Oregon to vote on the cap-and-trade bill and to limit the scope of bills to those consistent with the intent of voter approved short sessions. Opportunities for bipartisanship continue to exist if Democratic leaders are willing to work together."
