Job Title: Legislative Intern

Location: Remote or State Capitol, Salem, OR

Duration: Part time, limited duration for the 2022 Legislative Short Session (Start date of mid-to-late January through end date of mid-March, with some flexibility about specific start and end dates, and hours/days of work)

Compensation: Unpaid (for school credit), with the possibility of stipend **Application Deadline:** Position open until filled

Position Responsibilities: The Legislative Intern will work under the direct supervision of legislative staff with the primary areas of responsibility:

• Office Administration: Perform a variety of routine clerical tasks such as filing, typing, photocopying.

• **Constituent Services:** Under staff supervision, help respond to basic HD 13 constituent issues (via phone, email, letter, or in person) by providing resources and solutions.

• **Communications:** Gather background material for newsletters, social media, etc., and provide to staff for review.

• **Policy Work:** Complete research assignments on policy areas to expand knowledge in areas important to HD 13 constituency. Attend meetings and events with the Representative to learn about the legislative process.
