

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING 2020 OREGON LAWS (REGULAR AND FIRST AND SECOND SPECIAL SESSIONS)

Oregon Revised Statutes (2019 Edition) does not include new statutes or amendments to statutes enacted by the 2020 regular session and the 2020 first and second special sessions of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly. Changes to statutes by the 2020 regular session and the 2020 first and second special sessions will be reflected in the 2021 Edition of Oregon Revised Statutes.

Because the Acts of the 2020 regular session and the 2020 first and second special sessions are not incorporated into Oregon Revised Statutes (2019 Edition), you will need to use the 2019 Edition, the 2020 regular session law publication and the 2020 special session law publication to determine the current state of the law. The table of [“ORS Sections Amended, Repealed or ‘Added To’”](#) on page A-1 of the 2020 regular session law publication shows you which statutes published in Oregon Revised Statutes (2019 Edition) are affected by Acts of the 2020 regular session. The tables of [“ORS Sections Amended, Repealed or ‘Added To’”](#) beginning on pages SS20-T-1 and 2SS20-T-1 of the 2020 special session law publication show you which statutes are affected by Acts of the 2020 first and second special sessions. When working with a statute, use these tables to determine whether that statute is affected by the 2020 regular session and the 2020 first and second special sessions. If a table indicates that the statute is affected, see the chapter of [2020 Oregon Laws or 2020 Oregon Laws \(First and Second Special Sessions\)](#) that is cited and then find the section or sections listed as affecting that statute. Remember that a statute may be affected by one or more sections of a single session law chapter and that a statute also may be affected by one or more sections of other session law chapters.
