SB 761 assaults petition process
Supermajority wants to strip citizens' rights

SALEM, Ore.—When lawmakers fail to heed the voices of Oregonians, voters' only recourse is to refer these policies to the ballot with the hopes of repeal. The Democrats are pushing extreme policies and they are seeing the public outcry and heated outrage explode across the state.

To preemptively stop Oregonians from being able to repeal these extreme policies, they are working to undermine the petition process with Senate Bill 761.

Senate Republican Whip Dennis Linthicum, R-Klamath Falls, released the following statement:
