- [E-Subscribe](#) to committee agendas and email alerts about bills.
- **Agenda** posting deadlines:
  - 48 hours prior to a first public hearing in a House committee
  - 24 hours for all other types of meetings
- **Amendment** posting deadlines:
  - 4 hours for House committees
  - 1 hour for Senate committees
- [Register](#) to testify on bills using the online system.
- [Submit](#) written testimony using the online testimony portal.
- Fiscal and revenue impact statements must be distributed and reviewed by the committee before a measure is reported out.
- Timelines for filing minority reports are different from those in long session; see chamber and committee rules.
