- Use OLIS to find committee and bill information.
- E-Subscribe to committee agendas and email alerts about bills.
- Agenda posting deadlines
  - 72 hours prior to a first public hearing in a House committee
  - 48 hours for all other types of meetings
- Amendment posting deadlines
  - 4 hours for House committees
  - 1 hour for Senate committees
- Register to testify on bills using the online system.
- Submit written testimony using the online testimony portal.
- No measure shall be reported out of committee unless any fiscal and revenue impact statements have been distributed and reviewed by the committee.
- Timelines for filing minority reports are different than short session; see chamber and committee rules.
