### **Statement from Representative Susan McLain on Signing of House Bill 2680**

Rep. Susan McLain (D-Forest Grove) today applauded Gov. Kate Brown for signing 2680, which establishes a temporary moratorium on the use of standardized tests in evaluating schools and teachers.

"The one-size-fits-all approach to high-stakes testing does not provide a true picture of how are children are doing in school, or how we can help them best learn; nor does it provide sufficient information for evaluating teachers and schools," says Rep. McLain. "This bill means that we can push pause long enough to look at the test, analyze the results, and make sure we're using the best tools to evaluate and improve our schools."
