**Representative Mike McLane Sworn In For Third Term**

*House Republican Leader Also Named To Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water Committee*

**Salem, OR** – Representative Mike McLane (R-Powell Butte) today was sworn in for his third term as a member of the Oregon House and will represent House District 55 during the 78<sup>th</sup> Legislative Assembly. Rep. McLane will also serve again as House Republican Leader, a position he was first elected to by his peers in 2012.

“It’s an honor to again represent the residents and families of House District 55,” said Rep. McLane. “I will continue to advocate for the needs of rural Oregon by introducing and supporting legislation that increases economic development and improves the standard of living for families in the region.”

Rep. McLane will serve on the following committees for the 2015 session:

- Joint Ways & Means Committee
- Joint Legislative Administration Committee
- Joint Legislative Counsel

Speaker Tina Kotek today announced that Rep. McLane will serve on the Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water Committee. He replaces Rep. John Davis to solve a scheduling conflict.

Rep. McLane and his wife Holly reside in Powell Butte. They have two sons and a daughter. Rep. McLane was first elected to the Oregon House of Representatives in 2010. Mike Carew will serve as his Chief of Staff and Kate Virden joins his office as his Legislative Assistant. House District 55 includes Crook County and portions of Deschutes, Jackson, Klamath and Lake Counties.
