Monnes Anderson and Gorsek to Hold Town Hall Meeting

East County Legislators Seek Constituent Input

TROUTDALE – Senator Laurie Monnes Anderson (D-Gresham) and Representative Chris Gorsek (D-Troutdale) announced they will hold a joint Town Hall at 6:30 -7:30 p.m. next Tuesday, February 12 at Mt. Hood Community College.

“I’m looking forward to the 2013 Legislative Session and getting back to business on East County’s priorities: Reinvesting in education and getting people back to work,” said Sen. Monnes Anderson. “It is a distinct pleasure to serve once again in Salem, and I look forward to hearing from constituents next Tuesday.”

“This will be the first in a series of community town halls in the district,” said Gorsek. “It is vital that legislators not just speak to our constituents, we must give them opportunities to speak directly with us as often as possible.”

This first town hall will serve as an opportunity for Monnes Anderson and Gorsek to discuss their general legislative priorities and give constituents a chance to share their legislative concerns as session begins.
