Date: May 16, 2014

The following OSCR project team members will be working throughout the building:

- Several representatives from Riverside Engineering, Applied Professional Services (APS), and JE Dunn.

Date and time of work:

- Friday, May 30th, 2014 through Friday, June 6th, 2014
- Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. daily

Location of work:

- Exterior grounds of the Capitol and in the parking tunnel

Work to be performed:

- 2-3 representatives from Riverside Engineering will be conducting a topography survey of the Capitol grounds. They will begin at the main Capitol entrance (Zone 1 on the attached map) and will then move to Zone 2 and finish at Zone 3.
- Representatives from APS will be conducting a utility locate survey to locate all storm, sanitary, electrical, and data utilities on Capitol grounds.
- Upon completion of the utility survey, 2-3 representatives from JE Dunn will drill potholes by hand at utility locations closest to the building to determine their exact depth and location.
- Potholes will be filled and/ or capped the same day they are drilled.
- 2-3 representatives from Riverside Engineering will also be surveying the parking access and steam tunnels at the Northeast corner of the Ground Floor. A Capitol Facility Services Representative will escort Riverside Engineering while they conduct their survey.

Impacts:

- This work is not anticipated to impact building utilities.
- Utility survey crews will minimize the use of paint to mark utilities on hard surfaces out of consideration for the historic nature of the finishes.
- Potholing crews will place cones and safety signage around work areas to notify employees and the public of potential hazards and detours.
- The landscaping will be repaired to pre-existing condition in locations where potholing occurred.
