

# Notice of Work

To: Capitol Building

## OSCR project team members will be conducting work in the following areas:

Capitol Archives- Room C-064B

Press Corp- Room C-043A

Men's Locker Room- C-034

### Team members will consist of:

• 5-6 representatives from Brothers Concrete, JE Dunn and GRI.

#### Date and time of work:

Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014- Friday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014

• Hours of work: 5:30 p.m. - 12:00 a.m.

## Work to be performed:

- Representatives from JE Dunn and Brothers Concrete will be drilling 12 inch cores through the floor and concrete slab in the locations listed above on Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>. These holes will be approximately 12-14 inches deep.
- GRI and JE Dunn team members will be using a manual auger to drill an additional 8 feet down to take soil samples at core locations Thursday, March 13<sup>th</sup>- Friday, March 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Surrounding finishes (floors, walls, etc.) will be protected prior to drilling to prevent damage.

### Purpose of work:

Soil samples are being taken to determine what type of soil condition is below the ground floor, i.e.
rock, clay, etc., to better understand the existing conditions and aid the architects and engineers
with their design.

#### Impacts:

- The above listed rooms will be <u>closed</u> Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup> at 5:30p.m. through 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Spaces will be locked to prevent access.
- On Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, a portable generator will be placed in the parking garage and running from 5:30 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. to supply power to the core drill. The generator will be loud, but the sound should be contained in the garage. The generator could, potentially, be heard from street level outside and within the building.
- Upon completion of work, the holes will be filled, floor covering will be re-installed, and the space will be cleaned.
