The following OSCR project team members will be working throughout the building:

Several representatives from Architectural Resources Group (ARG) and Capitol Facility Services.

Date and time of work:

- Wednesday, May 21st, 2014 through Thursday, May 22nd, 2014
- A Capitol Facility Services representative will accompany the ARG team while they are performing their work.
- Team members will be in each space for approximately 30 minutes.

Location of work:

- The team will start on the 1st floor and work their way up to the Dome.
- They will work from the East side of the building to the West on each floor.
- Specific locations include:
 - 3rd floor Caucus rooms- Documenting condition of the skylights
 - 4th floor mechanical spaces- Documenting condition of the skylight and old light court
 - Committee Services offices 446 and 454- Documenting condition of skylights
 - State Treasurer's Office- Documenting interior finishes
 - Secretary of State Office- Documenting interior finishes
 - o Governor's Suite- Documenting interior finishes
 - Chambers- Documenting furniture and the platform
 - Vaults- Documenting existing condition
 - Restrooms- Document existing conditions
 - Dome- Documenting condition of spiral stairs, platform, etc.)
 - o Dome Roof- Documenting tile roof condition and condition of statue
 - Exterior Doors- Documenting existing condition

Work to be performed:

- Team members will be documenting existing conditions of interior finishes.
- The architects will be using cameras and iPads to document and in some locations will be using a ladder for a closer visual inspection.

Impacts:

 The team will be in each space for approximately 30 minutes in order to obtain all necessary information for their documentation. • The team is flexible in their sequence of visiting each location. If the time they arrive at your work area is not a good time for you, we are happy to reschedule for a more convenient time.

Purpose of work:

• This work is being done to document the existing condition of the interior finishes and assist in the overall design process.
