



Notice of Work- Exterior Diesel Tank Investigation

To: Capitol Building

From: Oregon State Capitol Renovation (OSCR) Team

Date: June 17, 2014

The following OSCR project team members will be working on the Capitol grounds:

- Several representatives from PBS Engineering

Date and time of work:

- Tuesday, July 1st, 2014 through Wednesday, July 2nd, 2014
- Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily

Location of work:

- The investigations will be done on the exterior of the Capitol.

Work to be performed:

- **Throughout the two days of work, a geophysical survey, utility locate survey and soil sampling will be done in the location outlined on the map below.**
- **Geophysical Survey: July 1st, 2014**
 - The survey is expected to take approximately one half day to complete and is noninvasive.
 - Surveyors will be using temporary marking paint or chalk on pavement to mark subsurface features and to identify the exact location of the tank.
- **Utility Locating: July 1st, 2014- July 2nd, 2014**
 - The survey is expected to take approximately one day and is noninvasive.
 - Surveyors will be marking existing utility locations with temporary marking paint or chalk.
- **Drilling & Soil Sampling: July 2nd, 2014**
 - The soil sampling will take approximately one day to complete and will be done between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
 - 2-4 holes will be drilled with a large drilling rig in the location outlined on the map below
 - Upon completion of the drilling and soil sampling, each hole will be backfilled and patched with concrete or asphalt to match the surrounding surface.

Impacts:

- While the drilling and soil sampling is occurring, the area outlined in yellow on the below map will be closed for parking and to pedestrians.
- The drilling will cause some noise from the drill rig and the actual drilling. However, drilling activities are expected to be limited to one day.
- It is possible that diesel fumes could be produced from the drill rig.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to aid in the design and planning of the Renovation.
