- 4-5 representatives from PBS Engineering and Capitol Facility Services.

Scheduled Date and Time of Work:

- Wednesday, August 27, 2014
- Thursday, August 28, 2014
- Between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. daily

Location of work:

- Public corridors and hallways, restrooms, stairwells, Hearing Room 50, Hearing Room 350, and Room 357
- Ground Floor - 4th floor of the 1938 building
- First floor of the 1977 House and Senate Wings

Work to be performed:

- Team members escorted by a Capitol Facility Services representative will be taking test samples from carpet and walls in public areas throughout the 1938 building and public areas on the first floor of the wings
- Approximate time to obtain a sample is 4-5 minutes
- The team will be on each floor obtaining samples for approximately 2-4 hours
- They will be working from the Ground Floor to the 4th floor over the two days they are on site

Impacts:

- A Facility Services representative will be escorting team members while this work is being conducted.
- There will be very minimal noise impacts, as they will not be using any noisy equipment to collect their samples. However, you may notice some areas where a chip 2" square of paint is missing.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to determine whether or not lead and/ or asbestos is present in these locations.
