Scheduled Date and Time of Work:

- Work will be done during night hours, from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m.

Location of work:

- Work will start in rooms 332 and 453.
- Upon completion of work in the above rooms, the team will move to the Ground Floor of the Capitol and work their way up through the 4th floor in the following locations:

 - Office 43- Capitol Press
 - 1938 Building Southwest Stairwell – 1st Floor

Work to be performed:

- Team members will be obtaining samples and testing structural materials. The samples and testing will include obtaining concrete cores, rebar removal, testing masonry strength, and performing a chemical analysis.

Impacts:

- The team will be escorted by a Facility Services representative.
- All work will be performed during night hours, 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. to avoid any disruption.
- Testing locations that are in public spaces will be tented off while the work is being performed.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to determine the structural integrity as well as the quality of the materials that currently exist within the Capitol Building. The information gathered will help to determine which areas need to be replaced and which areas can remain, if the Renovation project is approved to move forward into the Construction Phase.
