Scheduled Date and Time of Work:

- Tuesday, March 10th, 2015 to Monday, March 16th, 2015
- Work will be done between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Location of work:

- Public stairwells and corridors in the House and Senate wings on floors G through 3.

Work to be performed:

- Team members will be obtaining samples and testing structural materials. The samples and testing will include obtaining concrete cores, rebar removal, testing masonry strength, and performing a chemical analysis.

Impacts:

- Work is to be done during non-business hours, team members will be escorted by a Capitol Facility Services staff member and will only be accessing public spaces, therefore impacts to Capitol occupants are expected to be very minimal.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to determine the structural integrity as well as the quality of the materials that currently exist within the Capitol Building. The information gathered will help to determine which areas need to be replaced and which areas can remain, if the Renovation project is approved to move forward into the Construction Phase.
