The following OSCR project team members will be working in the Capitol:

- 1-2 representatives from Listen Acoustics, Inc. and Capitol Facility Services

Scheduled Date and Time of Work:

- The testing will be performed Friday, January 9th, 2015
- Work will be done between 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Location of work:

- Work will be performed in select vacant Senate and House offices.

Work to be performed:

- Team members will be measuring the acoustical conditions in the Senate and House wings using a noise generating speaker and handheld measuring device.
- Testing will be done in 4-8 offices
- The test will take approximately 10-20 minutes in each location.

Impacts:

- The team will be escorted by a Facility Services representative while the work is being conducted.
- All work will be performed in vacant areas to avoid disruption.
- This work will create loud noise, but should not impact the daily work functions as the work will be taking place in vacant areas.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to determine the baseline for sound transmission at the 550 Building, which will assist in the design.
