### **The following OSCR project team members will be working in the Capitol:**

- Representatives from JE Dunn and Mountain View Tree Service

### **Scheduled Date and Time of Work:**

- Pruning will be done on Wednesday, February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015 – Thursday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015

### **Location of work:**

- East and West sides of the Capitol near the entrances.

### **Work to be performed:**

- Team members will be pruning the four Camperdown Elms on the East and West side of the Capitol.

### **Impacts:**

- Safety tape will be set up around the tree near the East ADA ramp entrance while the trees on that side of the building are being pruned
- Team members will be using non-powered hand tools to perform the pruning, therefore noise impacts will be very minimal

### **Purpose of work:**

- If the project is approved to move forward, the Camperdown Elms will need to be relocated due to the excavation required to complete the project. The team has been working with an arborist on the plan for relocating the trees and has been given direction to prune the trees in preparation for the potential relocation.
