- Work will be done between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Location of work:

- Public stairwells and corridors in the House and Senate wings on floors G through 4 and the roof
- Testing will also be conducted in the following offices between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.:
 - H-180, S122M, and H-277: Thursday, March 19th
 - H-381, S-301 and H-480: Friday, March 20th

****The team conducting this work will be escorted by a Capitol Facility Services representative**

Work to be performed:

- Team members will be obtaining samples and testing structural materials. The samples and testing will include obtaining concrete cores, rebar removal, testing masonry strength, and performing a chemical analysis.
- Sample locations will be repaired the same evening in which the sample was obtained.

Impacts:

- Work is to be done during non-business hours, team members will be escorted by a Capitol Facility Services staff member.

Purpose of work:

- This investigation is being done to determine the structural integrity as well as the quality of the materials that currently exist within the Capitol Building. The information gathered will help to determine the appropriate seismic improvements for the Wings, which will inform the design of the renovated Capitol.
