Scheduled Date and Time of Work:

- The investigation is scheduled for the morning of **Saturday, May 9th**
- The investigation will be conducted between 7:00 a.m. And 12:00 p.m.

Location of work:

- Team members will be conducting the structural investigation above the House Chamber ceiling and the Turret Roof at the Pioneer statue.

Work to be performed:

- House Chamber- Team members will be investigating the concrete fireproofing in the House Chamber ceiling
- Pioneer Statue- Team members will be documenting the existing condition of the seismic anchorage in place at the Pioneer statue.
- Both investigations include visual inspection and photographic documentation

Impacts:

- Team members will be escorted by a Facility Services representative while the work is being conducted.
- There will be very minimal impacts to building occupants as this work does not require the use of tools and is occurring during non business hours.

Purpose of work:

- This work is being done to better inform the structural design of the renovation.
