- March 25th, 1993:
 - Scotts Mills Earthquake
 - Capitol suffered damage from earthquake
- June 17th, 2009:
 - Master Plan development and completion
 - Evaluation of existing facilities
 - Identification of current and future needs of the building for the next 20-30 years
 - May 2013 to December 2013:
 - Pre-Design Phase
 - Legislature approves funding for Design Phase during the 2013 Session
 - December 2013:
 - Design Phase Began

Funding

- Recommendation from the Capitol Master Plan Review Committee suggested project be funded in phases
- During the 2013 session, the Legislature approved \$34.5 million to move forward with the Design
 Phase of the project
 - We are currently *only* funded for the Design Phase, we expect to ask for approval and funding during the 2015 Legislative Session



Scope

The detailed scope will be determined during the current Design Phase of the project. The following are recommendations from the February 2013 Executive Report

- Seismic upgrade
- Infrastructure upgrades
- ADA upgrades
- Preservation and restoration of historic features
- Minor improvements



Where We Are Now & What to Expect

- This project has only been approved for the Design Phase
- Throughout the Design Phase, you can expect to see the IPD Core Team gathering information throughout the building
 - There may be instances where we need to access your work area. In that event, you will be contacted ahead of time



Potential Temporary Relocation

• **IF** the construction phase of the project is approved, the Capitol will need to relocate for a period of time.

- The team is researching options for relocation
 - Vacating at one time
 - Vacating in phases
